Paustian Spinal Chair

designed by PAUL LEROY

The Spinal Chair is a continuation of the Spinal Table System, which is a great success with both the business community and in private homes. The designer, Paul Leroy, has utilised the same principle in the design of the Spinal Chair, as can clearly be seen from the leg construction.

The chair consists of three basic elements: the actual leg construction, the swivel link, and the seat. The leg construction is made of steel, consisting of the familiar four-legged structural Spinal column, which provides the chair's supporting base. The swivel link is an important element in the chair's flexibility and practical use, as the legs are fixed. The Spinal Chair has been developed with two seat options: an upholstered option which is ideal for meeting rooms and conference rooms, where sitting comfortably over longer periods is important, and a seat option in laminated veneer - ideal for canteen use etc. It comes with or without arms and in a stool. Spinal Chair is also available with castors on a five star base.

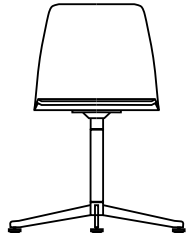

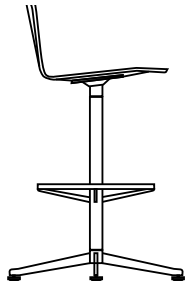

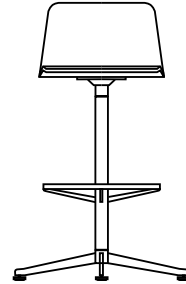
